At the hour of 10:00 a.m., the Board of Commissioners of McCone County, Montana, met in regular session with Alan Stempel, James Moos, and Ty Taylor present. Presiding Officer Alan Stempel called the meeting to order. The pledge of allegiance was recited. The agenda was approved.

The August 3, 2020 minutes were approved as read.

There were no Committee Reports.

Allen Rosaaen, South Road Foreman, met with the Board to discuss using overtime for work on the Prairie Elk road repair project, vehicle repairs and his visit with the State DES office about storm damage recovery.

Patti Schipman, Senior Center Administrator, met with the Board to discuss the Dodge Grand Caravan she bought from Eissinger Equipment to support her transportation plan. CARES Act funds will be used to pay for part of the vehicle.

The Board approved the temporary hire of experienced personnel to help operate county equipment, if approved by the Road Foreman and the Commissioners, to assist during emergency operations.

The meeting was opened to public participation at 1:00 p.m.

Tim Sorley, North Road Foreman, met with the Board to discuss the Prairie Elk road repair project, vehicle repairs, and personnel issues.

Suzie Wagner, Maintenance, met with the Board to provide an update on building maintenance issues and repairs.

Nancy Stempel, GIS Coordinator met with the Board to provide a GIS update. Commissioner Stempel abstained from the discussion.

Correspondence occupied the Board the remainder of the day.
