- E. Permit holder will inspect all items before burning to assure they are in DIRT FREE CONDITION.
- F. Permit holder is not to burn after dusk without express permission from Chief Beery.

I understand and agree to abide by the terms listed above. I understand that I am burning at my own discretion, and even though I am contacting McCone County Dispatch before burning, they are not giving me permission to burn. I understand that I am liable for all damages and the costs of extinguishing fires that get out of my control.
