

**OFFICE OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

Monday, March 8, 2021**

At the hour of 10:00 a.m., the Board of Commissioners of McCone County, Montana, met in regular session with Ty Taylor, James Moos and Alan Stempel present. Presiding Officer Ty Taylor called the meeting to order. The pledge of allegiance was recited. The agenda was approved.

The March 1, 2021 minutes were approved as read.

Allen Rosaaen, South Road Foreman, met with the Board to discuss North Rock Creek Road, the Hughes Road culvert repair project, and vehicle repairs. Commissioner Moos motioned to approve the purchase of a 1900 Hyster Grid Roller for approximately \$10,000. Commissioner Stempel seconded the motion. The motion passed 3-0.

Tim Sorley, North Road Foreman, met with the Board to discuss recovering a gravel pit, road repairs, and personnel issues.

There were no Committee Reports.

The Board reviewed and approved county claims for the month of February, 2021. Voucher #1044 for warrants #79351 through #79435 for the amount of \$167,682.56 was signed at this time. **(A copy of the claim register and voucher are on file in the Commissioners' files.)**

Nita Crockett, Treasurer, met with the Board to discuss the stipends that Roosevelt County paid to their employees and elected officials with CARES Act funding. Nita requested a comparable stipend for McCone County employees and elected officials. The Board will research paying stipends to employees and elected officials.

The meeting was opened to public participation at 1:00 p.m.

The Board approved the transfer of the farmland lease for county land at township 18N, Range 46E, Section 24: E1/2W1/2; W1/2NE1/4 from Edward Brost to Ryan Brost. **(A copy of the lease is on file in the Commissioners' files.)**

Correspondence occupied the Board the remainder of the day.

The meeting adjourned at 5:00 p.m.
