**Monday, March 28, 2022**

At the hour of 10:00 a.m., the Board of Commissioners of McCone County, Montana, met in regular session with Alan Stempel, and Ty Taylor present. James Moos was attending the MACRS Conference in Great Falls. Acting Presiding Officer Alan Stempel called the meeting to order. The pledge of allegiance was recited. The agenda was approved.

The March 21, 2022 minutes were approved as read.

Commissioner Stempel reported on the Library Board meeting he attended, in Circle, on March 23, 2022.

Commissioner Stempel reported on the Eastern Montana Mental Health Board meeting he attended in Miles City on March 24, 2022.

Allen Rosaaen, South Road Foreman, met with the Board, by phone, to discuss vehicle repairs and the MACRS conference. The Board approved the request to repair a pickup for approximately \$1,100.

The Board reviewed the Express Vote Contract with Circle Public Schools for the 2022 Election. Commissioner Taylor motioned to approve the contract. Commissioner Stempel seconded the motion. The motion passed 2-0. **(A copy of the contract is on file in the Commissioners' files.)**

The Board met with Lucy Corbett, Eastern Montana Mental Health Center Prevention Services Director, by phone, to discuss an attempt to hire a half time Prevention Specialist in McCone County.

The meeting was opened to public participation at 1:00 p.m.

At the hour of 2 p.m. the Board conducted the county vehicle bid opening. The high bid on the 1970 Chevy C-60 was \$1,800. The high bid on the 2000 Ford F-350 XL Red Fire Engine was \$7,501. No bids were received for the 1992 Freightliner semi-tractor, the 1985 Kenworth COE semi-tractor, or the 2000 Ford Expedition. Commissioner Taylor moved to approve the bids and Commissioner Stempel seconded. The motion passed 2-0. **(Copies of the bids are on file in the Commissioners' files.)**

Suzette Wagner, Maintenance, met with the Board to discuss repairs, equipment purchases, a potential county vehicle and maintenance issues.

Correspondence occupied the Board the remainder of the day.

The meeting adjourned at 4:00 p.m.
