Monday, May 9, 2022

At the hour of 9:00 a.m., the Board of Commissioners of McCone County, Montana, met with Shannon Chamberlain, MACO Insurance, Angie Belus, Circle Insurance, and Sherry Kluth, Clerk and Recorder, to review the county's Property and Casualty Insurance. The Board approved the insurance policy for 2022-2023. The Board discussed the liability insurance for the Bump and Run race in September.

At the hour of 10:00 a.m., the Board of Commissioners of McCone County, Montana, met in regular session with James Moos, Alan Stempel, and Ty Taylor present. Presiding Officer James Moos called the meeting to order. The pledge of allegiance was recited. The agenda was approved.

The May 2, 2022 minutes were approved as read.

Commissioner Taylor reported on the Fairboard meeting he attended, in Circle, on May 2, 2022.

Commissioner Moos and Commissioner Stempel reported on the meeting they attended with McKinstry Industries they attended, in Circle, on May 4, 2022.

Allen Rosaaen, South Road Foreman, met with the Board to discuss road repairs to Beauty Creek Road and Rock Creek Road, gravel projects, culvert purchases, and blading roads. The Board approved the purchase of cutting edges for the road graders for approximately \$2,000. The Board discussed potential engine repairs for a truck.

Jeff Gates, DES District Representative, met with the Board to discuss the EMPG plan, DES issues, and future plans.

The Board met with Ryan Montgomery, Montana Conservation Corps, by phone, to discuss a potential weed spraying crew for May through August in 2022.

The Board contacted Blue Rock Distributing, by phone, to discuss water deliveries and rentals.

The meeting was opened to public participation at 1:00 p.m.

The Board approved the agreement with the Area 1 Agency on Aging to continue support for McCone County residents.

The Board approved a letter of support for the McCone County Fair PRCA Rodeo Committee in support of the McCone County Fairgrounds Arena as part of the T Mobile Hometown Grant application.

Brant Gordon, Sanitarian, met with the Board, by phone, to discuss temporary camper parking and waste disposal.

Tim Sorley, North Road Foreman, met with the Board to discuss vehicle repairs, grass planting, blading roads, and road repairs.

Correspondence occupied the Board the remainder of the day.

The meeting adjourned at 4:00 p.m.
